The Board of Commissioners of the Port of Bay City Authority of Matagorda County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, hereby gives notice in accordance with the <u>Texas Government Code</u>, section 551 et seq, that a public meeting is to be held at the office of the Authority, **1305 Seventh Street**, **Bay City**, **Texas**, <u>Thursday</u>, <u>June 11</u>, <u>2020 at 6:30pm</u>. The purpose of the meeting is for:

- 1. Action of the minutes of the regular meetings of March 12, 2020, April 9, 2020, and May 14, 2020;
- 2. Presentation, approval, and ratification of bills;
- 3. Presentation and approval of financial reports and monthly billing and collection reports for February, March, April, and May 2020;
- 4. Discuss and take required action on delinquent accounts and pending suits for collection;
- 5. Discuss and take required action on activity at the Port and Matagorda Harbor;
- 6. Discuss and take required action regarding refunding rent paid/charged to Waterfront Restaurant and Harbor Bait & Tackle during closure of Matagorda Harbor;
- 7. Discuss and take required action regarding the Interlocal Agreement between Matagorda County and the Port of Bay city Authority of Matagorda County, Texas for investment services;
- 8. Discuss, consider, and possibly act concerning requirements to obtain and operate an interactive website for the Port of Bay City Authority;
- Discuss, consider, and possibly act concerning approval of a Drill site Relocation Agreement between the Port Authority and F.A.S.H. FAMILY PARTNERSHIP 1992, a Texas General Partnership;
- 10. Discuss, consider, and possibly act to approve the location and provisions of a proposed AEP Texas Inc, a Delaware Corporation, easement on approximately 99.97 acres of land owned by the Port of Bay City Authority north of the current OXEA plant;
- 11. Discuss and take required action concerning Air Liquide's implied request for a rail spur corridor across the southeast portion of the 100 acre tract at the Port of Bay City;
- 12. Discuss and take required action concerning alternate electrical transmission line routes to accommodate a possible rail spur from the 100 acre tract across FM 3057 to the Air Liquide property;
- 13. Discuss and take required action concerning AEP's request for a 3.2 acre substation easement located on the 20 acre Air Liquide property and exclusive rights to provide electrical power to said property;
