The workshop was called to order at 8:00am by Commissioner George Harrison. The Commissioners and staff travelled to the Port of Corpus Christi for a tour of their facility. Upon arrival at the Port of Corpus Christi, the Commissioners and staff met with Jeff Pollock, TJ Gonzales, Clark Robinson, Kent Britton, Sean Strawbridge, Bryan Gulley, and Yudi Takizawa. Members of the Port of Corpus Christi staff reviewed the various operations of the port facility including the history of the port, the growth of the port, various products being exported, the customers and partners utilizing the port, military usage of the port, and the port's infrastructure. The ship channel improvement project was discussed as well as the potential hydrogen hub.
